

Crusade Developments accepts that they have an obligation under the Statutory Legislation requirements to ensure the health and safety of each of their workers, contractors suppliers, etc, whilst at work, and that the health and safety of other persons is not affected by the way that Crusade Developments conducts its undertaking.

While ensuring that all reasonably practical steps are taken to safeguard workers and other persons at the workplace, Crusade Developments recognizes risk cannot be completely eliminated. Risks associated with work conducted by Crusade Developments, shall be managed in accordance with this manual.

Crusade Developments shall ensure that all reasonable action is taken, so as to achieve the set objectives and targets in accordance with the CD-SAF-018-01 Occupational Health & Safety Manual by ensuring:

- That the risk of injury to individual workers' health and safety whilst at work is reduced to As Low As Reasonably Practicable through the process of risk management;
- The health and safety of other persons is not affected by the way that Crusade Developments conducts its undertaking;
- That activities at the workplace are safe and without risk of disease or injury to members of the public, at or near the workplace;
- That plant and substances provided by Crusade Developments are safe and without risk of disease or injury to persons at the workplace;
- Health and safety consultation with Crusade Development employees, contractors, suppliers and clients is undertaken as part of the risk management process.

The target set by Crusade Developments in relation to its health and safety objectives is to ensure Zero Injuries through the continued improvement of its systems so as to eliminate work related injuries and illnesses. The management of Crusade Developments measures the performance and the compliance of the company occupational health and safety systems in conjunction with the requirements of AS/NZS4804:2001 through the conduct of workplace inspections and management systems audits.

Crusade Developments Management shall ensure where necessary that adequate resources are available, such as to maintain a high level of occupational health and safety standards and ensure that risk is managed at an acceptable level.
